Tax Deduction Information

You are responsible for determining the value of your donation. Federal law requires that donated items be in good used condition or better to receive a tax deduction. As a rule of thumb, the value of your donation is equal to the price The Landing Zone is able to sell the item for.

Per IRS regulations, donors of items valued at \$500 or more should file form 8283 with their federal tax return. If your donation is more than \$5000, you must submit an appraisal and two completed copies of IRS form 8283 to The Landing Zone and the IRS.
